COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP) FLEXIBILITY GUIDANCE: 2021- 2022
FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
SUMMARY:

1. STUDENT ELIGIBILITY: Into a College CCP Program:
 - Unweighted GPA of 3.00 or Higher
And/or
 - College Readiness Scores on ACT or SAT
or
 - ACCUPLACER
2. INTENT TO PARTICIPATE FORM:
 - Return to LUHS: Due by May 1, 2021
 - LUHS: Option to Accept Later
3. P/F GRADING: Not Permitted if the Course Normally Grades (A-B-C-D-F)
 - EXCEPTION: A COVID-19 Disruption Occurs, and the College Offers a P/F Option to All the Students in a Course that is Usually Graded (A-B-C-D-F). This is an Option, and this becomes the Student's Choice or Decision. Student should Discuss with College Advisor and his/her High School Counselor.
4. STUDENT WITHDRAW: Student must Withdraw from a Course Before the 15th Day (Census) of Class or Face Possible Financial Responsibility for the Course. Payment of the Course to Liberty Union- Thurston School District.
 - EXCEPTION: A COVID 19 Disruption Occurs, and the College Offers a No-Fault Withdrawal Option after the Census Date to All Students. A Student May Choose this No-Fault Option. Should Discuss the No-Fault Option Decision with his/her College Academic Advisor and his/her High Counselor. This Withdraw Could Impact a Student's GPA/Class Rank, Future Financial Aid for College after High School, and Athletic Eligibility.
5. STUDENT REIMBURSEMENT FOR UNDERPERFORMING STUDENTS:
 - UNDERPERFORMING STUDENT: A Student that (1) Withdraws from or Receives No Credits for Two or More Courses (2) Earns Less than 2.00 Cumulative Minimum GPA on all CCP Courses. For a student Taking Courses through Both OU-L and ZSC, the Cumulative GPA is Calculated Together with Both Colleges. THE UNDERPERFORMING STUDENT May Be Placed on CCP PROBATION. The Student Has Two Consecutive Terms on CCP PROBATION to Raise his/her GPA to 2.00 or Higher, or the Student is Dismissed from the CCP Program. This Dismissal Includes CCP Courses Offered at the Student's High School.
 - A Student's Underperformance Does Impact the Student's GPA and Does Appear on his/her College and High School Transcripts.
 - Schools May Seek Financial Reimbursement if a Student Earns a Failure or No Credit Grade and the Student is not Economically Disadvantaged.
 - EXCEPTION: Student Earns a Failure or No Credit Grade, and the Student Can Demonstrate that the No Credit Grade was a Direct Result of the COVID- 19 Pandemic, then the High

School May Not Seek Reimbursement. Additionally, the No Credit Grade May Not Be Used for the Calculation or Determination of Underperforming Status.

6. IN PERSON COMMUNICATION, ACTIVITIES, MEETINGS: High School Counselor Typically Holds In-Person Group Meetings and Individual Meetings as Needed. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic Group Meetings will be Remote, and for an Individual Meeting the Remote Option Should Be Used when possible.
